Task I

Variant I

Text. Family Matters

Youth is a very complicated period when young people are undergoing from childhood to adulthood. There are many reasons why a teenager's behavior may become violent. Young people are facing psychological problems that may cause aggression and lead to the rejection of adult values and experiences or to rebellion. Wishing to prove their independence young people may commit various offences, or run away from home and use violence against their peers. Sometimes young people's antisocial behavior disappears with the transition to adulthood. But some of them create criminal groups or become involved in the activities of adult criminal groups. Young people's lives and behavior are greatly influenced by many factors: their family, friends, neighbourhood as well as by the social, economic, political and cultural conditions in the country they live in. Many children and teenagers suffer from domestic violence. If teenager's parents are hostile to each other, to their children or to other family members, the teenager is likely to have similar behavior. Besides, children who do not receive adequate parental supervision are more likely to become involved in criminal activities.

Variant II
